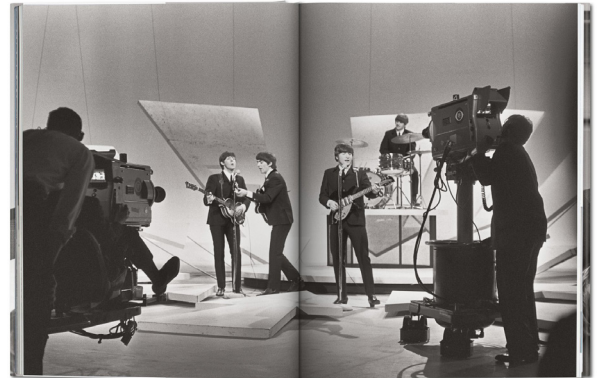
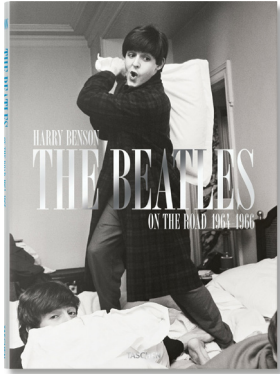
Utagawa Hiroshige (1797-1858) was one of the last great artists in the ukiyo-e tradition. Ukiyo-e was a particular genre of art that flourished between the 17th and 19th centuries and came to characterize the Western world's visual idea of Japan. Ukiyo-e scenes often represented the bright lights and attractions of Edo (modern-day Tokyo). Though he captured a variety of subjects, Hiroshige was most famous for landscapes. This reprint is made from one of the finest complete original sets of woodblock prints belonging to the Ota Memorial Museum of Art in Tokyo. It pairs each of the 120 illustrations with a description, allowing readers to immerse themselves in these beautiful, vibrant vistas that became paradigms of Japonisme and inspired Impressionist, Post-Impressionist and Art Nouveau artists alike.

Openly queer, she challenged conceptions of gender and sexuality in her art, which also served as her refuge. Though her paintings are held in major collections, Brooks's influence in modernist circles of the early twentieth century is largely underexplored. This new publication, guided by Brooks's own impressionistic musings, bridges an important gap between the art and the artist. An introduction by Lauren O'Neill-Butler explores Brooks's role as an artist in the early twentieth century through the lens of gender and sexuality.
