In a saucepan over a medium flame, boil the garlic cloves with three cups water for 10 minutes. Remove from heat, strain out the garlic cloves with a fine-mesh sieve and mix through the lemon juice and raw honey. Enjoy!



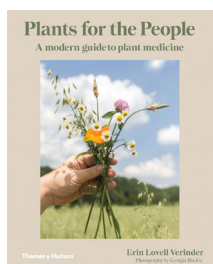
