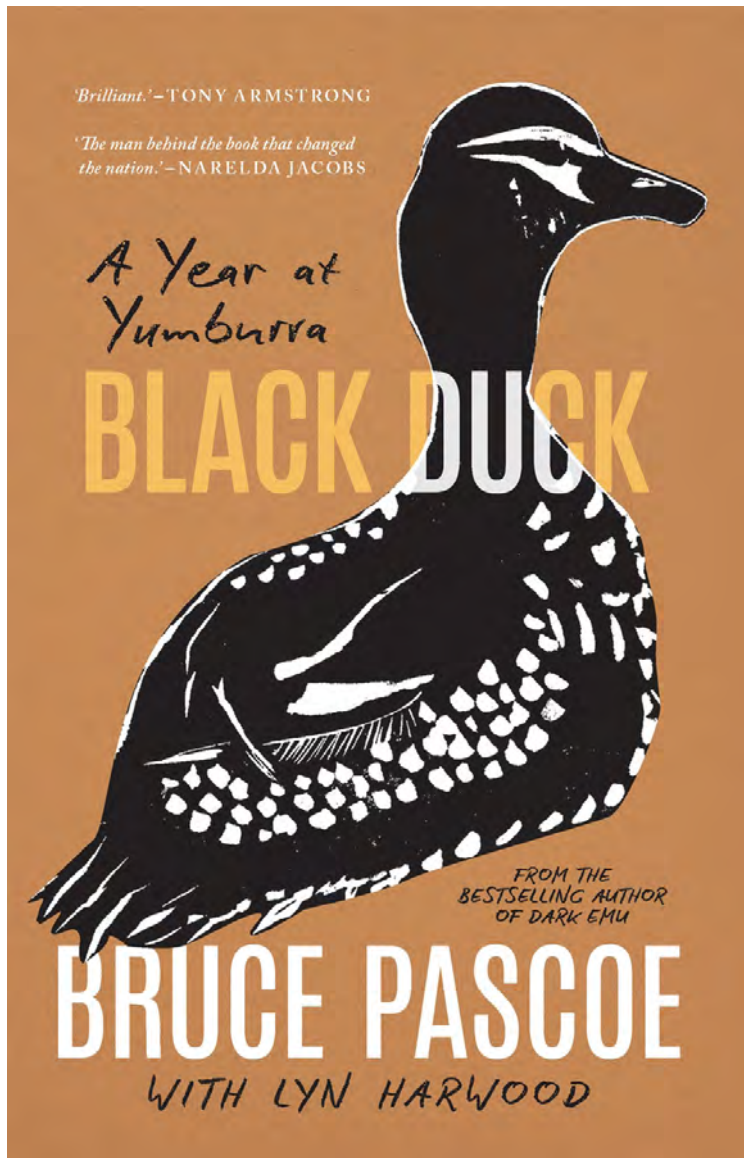

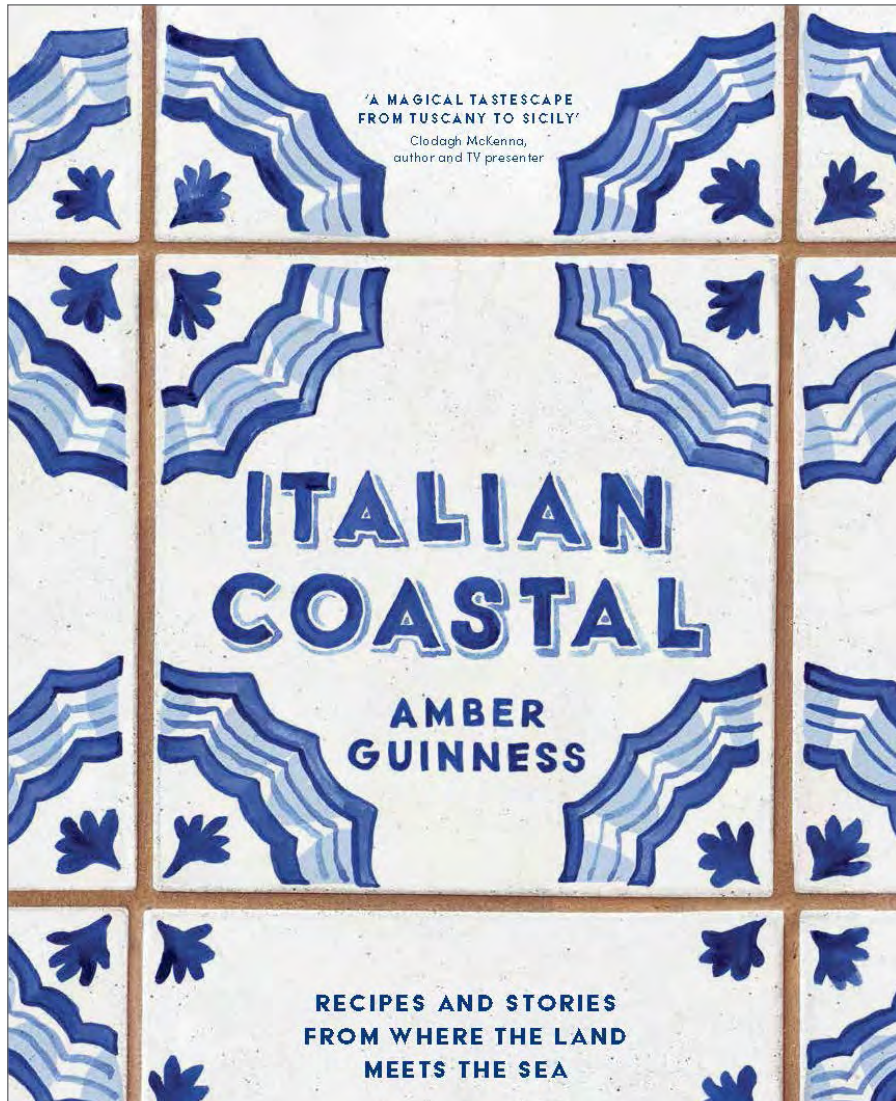

LIPARI, AEOLIAN ISLANDS

Caponata eoliana con mozzarella di bufala

CAPONATA WITH BUFFALO MOZZARELLA

This recipe brings together two great culinary traditions by pairing buffalo mozzarella (which is made in Campania, near Naples) with caponata, possibly one of the most emblematic dishes of Sicily and the Aeolian Islands. To me this dish is representative of the islands' remote position in the Tyrrhenian, directly on the historic trading route between Palermo and Naples. Caponata reflects key influences from Sicily's varied cultural past – sweet and sour from the Arabs, and tomatoes from the Spanish. It pairs beautifully with the slightly acidic milky taste of buffalo mozzarella, and is particularly heavenly scooped up with a piece of sourdough (the Italians call the action of scooping up any remaining sauce with bread as doing a 'scarpetta' or little shoe). As one surly Sicilian cook once told me, a traditional caponata takes a long time to make because it involves so much chopping and frying – her version called for each ingredient to be deep-fried separately in batches, so I do see why she found it irksome, though the result was divinely rich and unctuous.

This recipe opts for a less time-consuming method. The aubergine is roasted in the oven to make the dish a little lighter, but feel free to fry it for 5 minutes in a generous splash of vegetable oil if you prefer. I usually use the salted large capers from Salina, soaked in water for 2 hours, although you could also use capers in brine, which don't need any soaking.

Since its inception, they have addressed different typologies, such as pavilions, the rehabilitation of historic buildings, different interventions in the Tippeme bird sanctuary, the CODAN office and warehouse building, and museum installations. Their works featured in this issue speak to us of slow construction times, alien to the speed of Instagram, of images elaborated slowly that are capable of permeating both the entire local constructive translation and the landscape, whether natural or urban, to which they belong.
