For thousands of generations the health of Australia's First Peoples was grounded within the sacred lands of Mother Earth. Good health was not something to be sought and attained. It occurred naturally because lifestyle and diet were inextricably connected to Country and culture. Colonisation damaged this connection, but much is being done to rebuild and nurture it.
