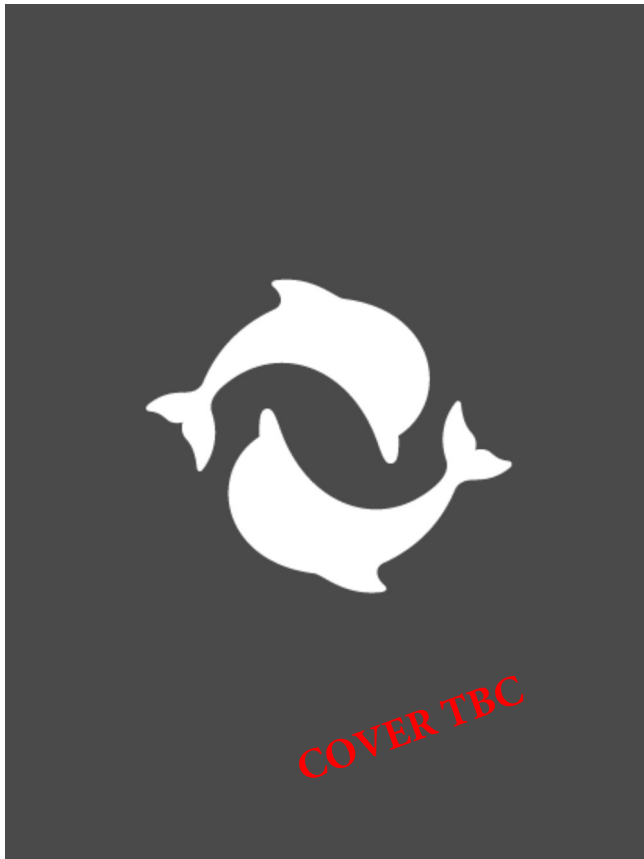

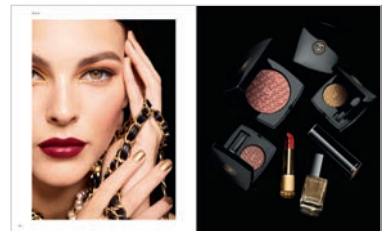


Chanel. The Allure of Makeup *Natasha A Fraser*
