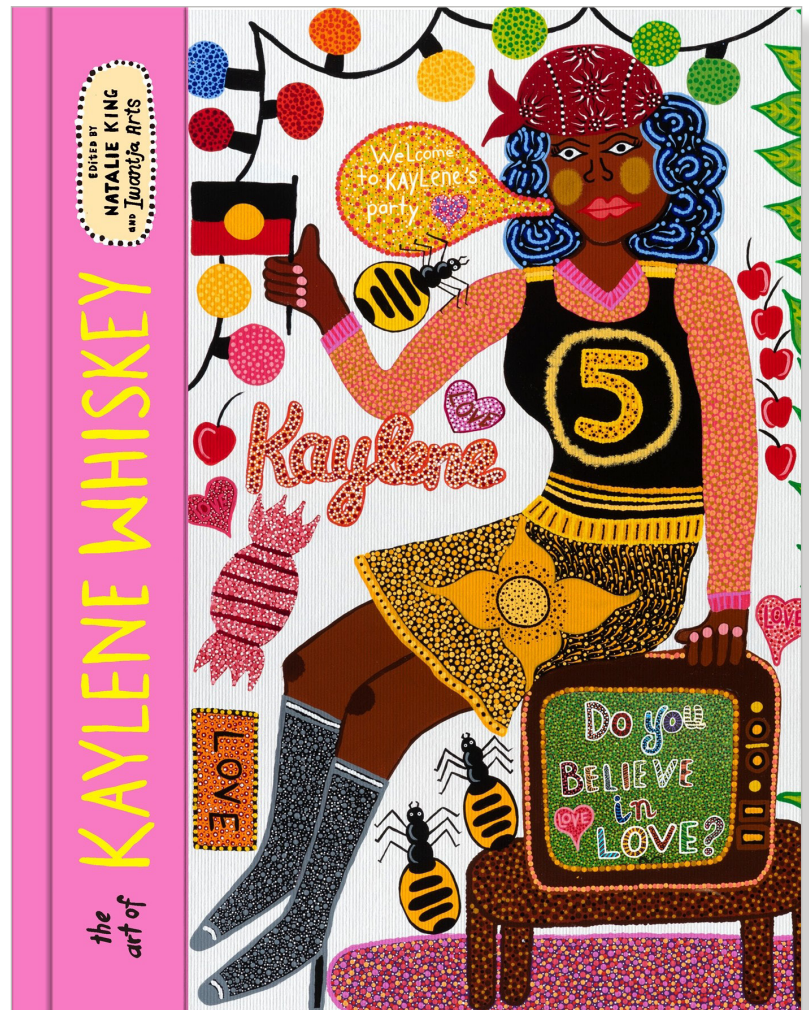
The Art of Kaylene Whiskey: Do You Believe in Love?

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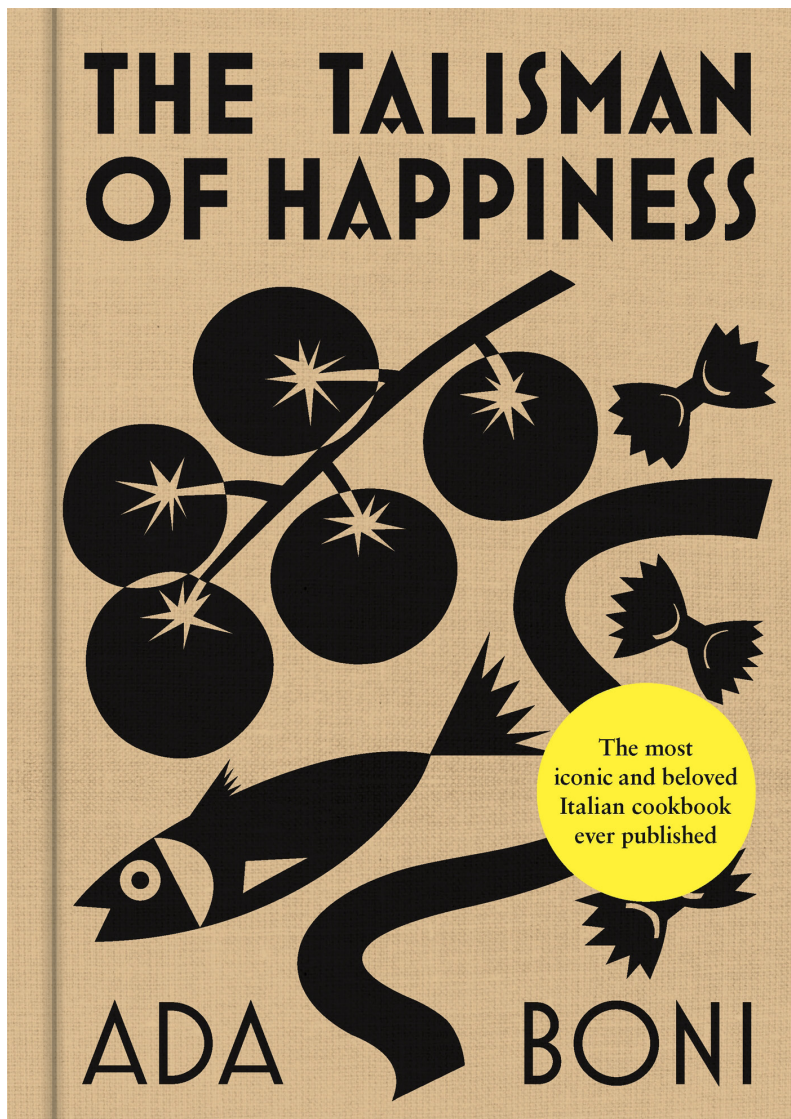

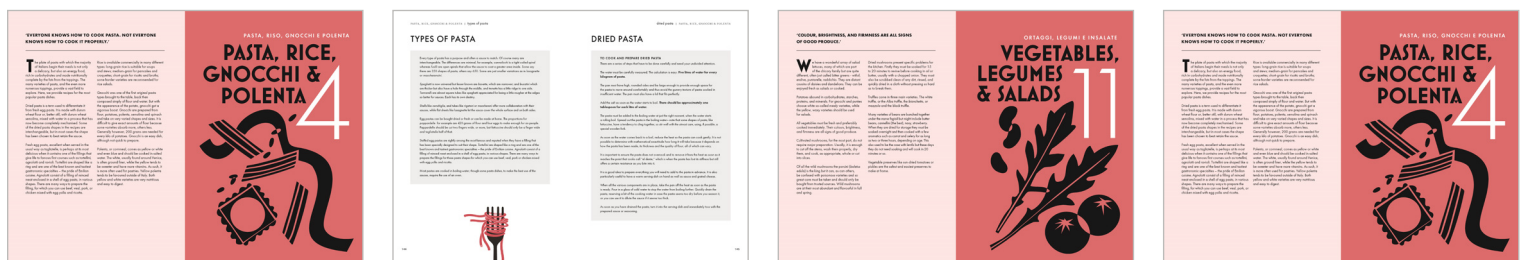

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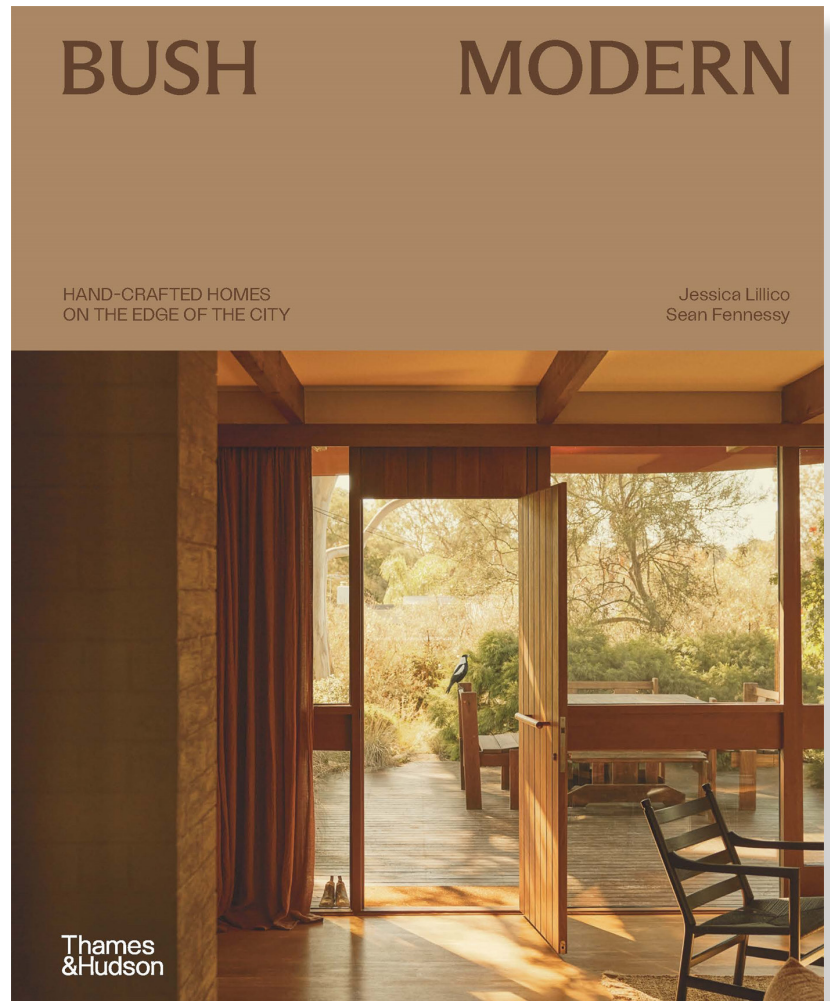

In the bushy north-eastern fringe of Melbourne, an enduring, uniquely Australian architectural aesthetic has been quietly gaining recognition.
